bracket finals. 2 games total pins.
Event will be on a Kegel Challenge Shot

Tournament Rules:

- This is a USBC certified tournament, so all rules will be governed by the USBC.
- All bowlers must have a current USBC certification for the 2024-2025 season.
- This is a handicap event. We will use your 2023-2024 highest average of at least 21 games converted to Challenge.
- The 10 pin rule WILL be in effect. (USBC Rule #319a)
- Teams must consist of one adult and one youth bowler of any gender.
- We encourage all adults to have completed the SafeSport Certification but it is not required per USBC Rules.
- Team Handicap will be calculated at 90% of 440.
- The Prize Fund will be returned 100%. All teams in the bracket will receive payment. The youth portion of payment will be put into their SMART account.
- Attire: Bowlers are expected to wear a shirt with a collar. The shirt does not have to have your name on the back. Please dress appropriately. No sweatpants allowed.
- The weight hole rule, dry towel rule, and surface adjustment rule will be in play.
 - No surface adjustments allowed after the completion of practice. Only a dry towel is allowed to be used on the surface of the bowling ball once practice is completed.
- Check-in will begin at 1 PM. Walk-ins will be accepted during this time on a first-come, first-served basis until 10 minutes prior to the beginning of practice. Practice will begin at 2 PM.
- All teams will bowl 8 games. Teams will move one lane to the right after each game.
- The top 8 teams will bowl a single elimination bracket finals. 2 games total pins will decide the winners.
- Ties will be broken through a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.
- The tournament director will get final say in any issues, and this decision is final unless an appeal is made in writing per USBC rule #329 and sent to the Lafayette USBC association.
