1. Partner with a Local Bowling Alley

- **Revenue Sharing:** Some alleys may agree to share a portion of the proceeds from ticket sales, food, and beverages with the PTA/PTO.

2. Determine Event Structure

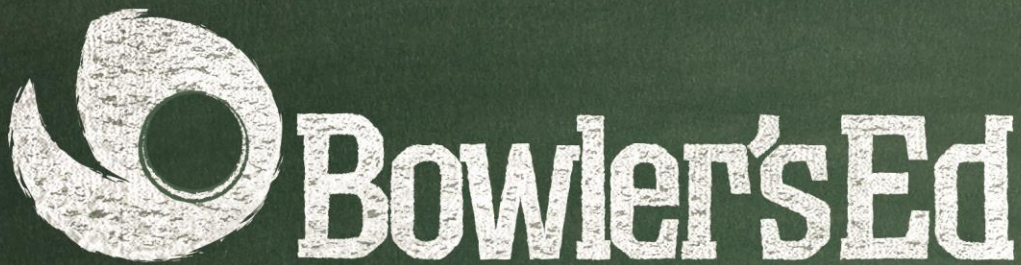
- **Team Play:** Have a baker style competition.
- **Tournament Style:** Organize a friendly competition with different rounds and small prizes for winners.
- **Theme Night:** Host a themed bowling night, like "Glow Bowling," 80s night, or costume bowling.

3. Ticket Sales

- **Pre-Sell Tickets:** Sell tickets in advance to ensure attendance and secure upfront funds.
- **Bundle Deals:** Offer family packages or include extras like pizza or a drink for a higher ticket price.

4. Add-On Fundraising Activities

- **Silent Auction:** Set up an auction table with donated items or baskets.
 - **Raffles:** Sell raffle tickets for prizes like bowling gift cards or other community-donated items.
 - **Sponsorships:** Partner with local businesses to sponsor lanes, with their names displayed at the lanes.

5. Promote the Event

- **Social Media:** Advertise on PTO/PTA social media pages, school newsletters, and local community groups.
 - **Flyers and Posters:** Distribute materials at school and in the community.
 - **Teacher/Principal Participation:** Draw a crowd by having teachers or the principal participate or challenge students and parents.

 - **50/50 Raffle:** Half of the pot goes to the winner, and the other half supports the PTO/PTA.
 - **Photo Booth:** Set up a fun, themed photo booth for participants.

- **Thank You Notes:** Publicly thank participants and sponsors via social media and newsletters.
 - **Highlight Funds Raised:** Share how the funds will support school projects or initiatives.
