



How to Run a Junior Gold Qualifier | Tournament

1. Download the Junior Gold Tournament Handbook, found under the *Event Director Guides* section of www.bowl.com/juniorgold.
2. After reviewing the Junior Gold Tournament Handbook, determine:
 - a. When and where your event(s) will be held.
 - b. What will be the format of your event(s).
 - c. The cost of the entry fee for your event(s).
3. Determine the rules and policies for your event(s).
 - a. Include the event(s) date(s), cost, format, eligibility, and how Junior Gold advancers are determined.
 - b. Include these Junior Gold specific policies:
 - i. Participants must be USBC Youth & Junior Gold members.
 - ii. A minimum of 4 participants in order to award a spot.
 - iii. Are spots determined by ratio (1:4 – 1:10) or Champion.
 - iv. Scratch competition only.
 - v. Provide a tiebreaker policy for final advancing spot.
 - c. Will you offer EARP or Major Fraction? (See Handbook for details)
 - d. Is this a Premier Event, where the tournament would cover any or all expenses for the advancer attending the Junior Gold Championships?
4. Certify the tournament with USBC, through the USBC Online Tournament Certification Program, found at BOWL.com/Rules.
5. With your rules & event policies completed, submit your event through the Junior Gold Qualifying Event Portal (BOWL.com/JuniorGold, under Event Director Guides) for approval.
 - a. This should be done one month prior to your event.
 - b. A deposit for a minimum of one reserved spot should be included, along with a copy of your rules.
6. Conduct your Event.
7. Once conducted, complete your event by uploading the results, advancer(s) and alternate(s) through Post Event Management in the Junior Gold Qualifying Event Portal.
8. After any balances are settled, your advancer(s) are notified by email of their advancement through your event.
